Other than that, I have been planning, developing and programming two applications. As you all may know, before my retirement, I was an IT professional. Although the work itself allowed me little time to practice what I liked doing best. It still allowed me to learn and play with many different program applications, how they worked and played with each other.

Anyway, in short. (And it seems, I am never that. In height, maybe, but not in keystrokes.) I spent a lot of time learning and using different programming languages. And now that I'm retired, I have a lot more time on my hands to play and develop programs with them.

Get to the point, Aubrey! (Man, do you ever shut up?) So, the two programs I wrote:

First: I needed a way to pick poems for my book publications. You see, I write plenty of poems, and many times they don't see publication until years later. So, in order to help me pick out the poems to be published for each book, I thought it would be much easier if I had some type of random poem picker. Therefore, I wrote a program to randomly go through all my poems I've written in a given year and pick ones for publication. I set it up in a way that I can tell it how many poems I want it to pick in a chosen category, and to keep track of the picks so that they would not be accidentally chosen again.

Second: once I wrote that program and got it working the way I wanted it to, (with a little bit of help from my friend, AI). I thought, wouldn't it be great if I had one for my website too. So, I wrote a smaller little program based on some of the things I learnt from the first one. Customized it more to fit the needs of my site and named it: Website Poem Picker. (I know, original as hell.)

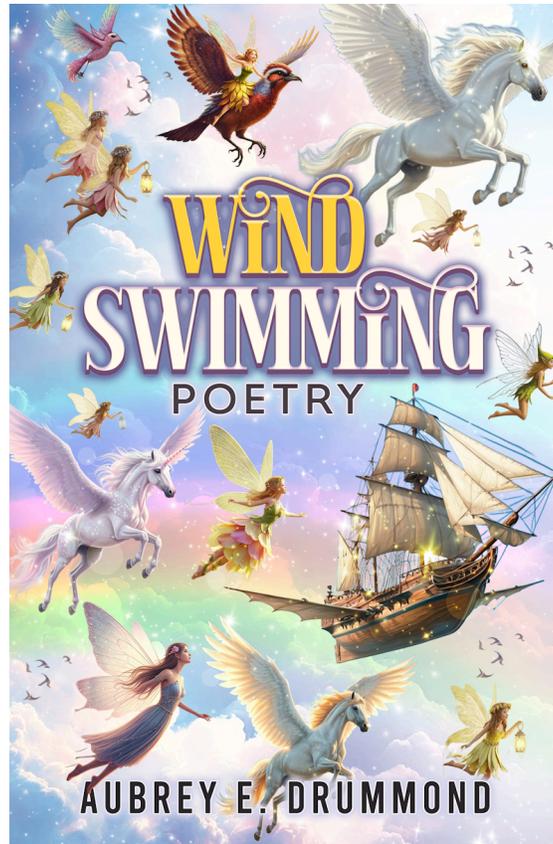
